Other Program Notes:

First Discipline (24 credits): Choose from English (ENG), History (HST) or Religious Studies (BIB or TH). At least 10 credits must be 300-level or higher.

Second Discipline (12 credits): Choose from English (ENG), History (HST), Linguistics (LIN), Philosophy, or Fine Arts. At least 6 credits must be 300-level or higher.

Consult with faculty advisor to plan First and Second Discipline courses. Some additional electives may be needed if discipline courses also fulfill Liberal Arts or Bible/Theology core requirements.
